<sup>14</sup> When they came to the crowd, a man came to him, knelt before him, <sup>15</sup> and said, "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and he suffers terribly; he often falls into the fire and often into the water. <sup>16</sup> And I brought him to your disciples, but they could not cure him." <sup>17</sup> Jesus answered, "You faithless and perverse generation, how much longer must I be with you? How much longer must I put up with you? Bring him here to me." <sup>18</sup> And Jesus rebuked the demon, <sup>[d]</sup> and it <sup>[e]</sup> came out of him, and the boy was cured instantly. <sup>19</sup> Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" <sup>20</sup> He said to them, "Because of your little faith.
